**MANUFACTURING DIRECTIONS**

1. Wear masks and gloves
2. Combine cholestyramine and water in mortar and pestle to yield an orange liquid.
3. Put Aquaphor® ointment onto ointment pad, gradually add in cholestyramine liquid to combine.
4. Transfer into ointment pots. Refrigerate.
