EQUIPMENT

- Glass mortar and pestle
- Glass stirring rod
- Glass graduated cylinder

MANUFACTURING DIRECTIONS

1. Using the mortar and pestle, crush the tablets into a fine powder
2. Levigate the powder with a small amount of the vehicle to form a smooth paste. Keep adding more vehicle by geometric dilution until a liquid is formed
3. Transfer the suspension to the graduated cylinder, rinsing the remaining ingredient from the mortar with more vehicle
4. QS to the final volume with the vehicle. Stir well.
5. Transfer to the amber glass or plastic bottle.
