CHEO's Super Helpers

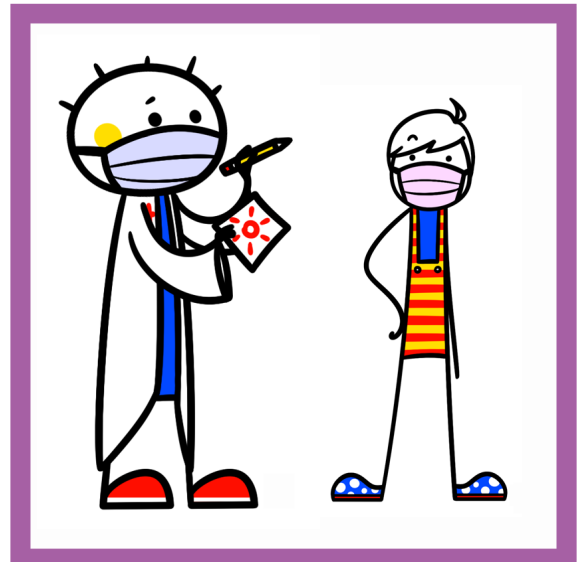


These are CHEO's Super Helpers! They keep the hospital clean and make sure the germs don't want to stay.

They might check my temperature with this tool too.



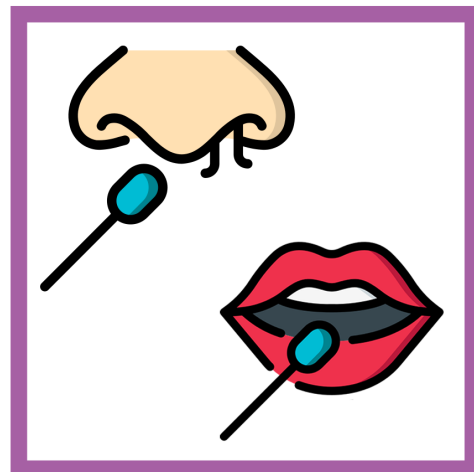
The Super Helpers will also put a special cuff on my arm. It feels like a big squeeze.
